

ICE HOCKEY Canada's official winter sport and the most popular sport on TV. In this cold, northern country, many people learn to skate as children, at public ice rinks or on frozenlakes. Many boys and girls sign up for junior hockey and continue playing as adults. Canada has seven professional teams that play in the National Hockey League. The NHL also includes 24 teams from the USA. Every year, these teams compete for the Stanley Cup, which is the oldest hockey award in North America. It's named after Lord Frederick Stanley, who established the competition in 1893.

CANADIAN FOOTBALL is another popular spectator sport in Canada. It's quite similar to American football because the players wear helmets, shoulder pads and other types of protection. However, Canadian teams have twelve players (instead of only eleven) and the playing field is larger. Many Canadian high schools and universities have football teams that compete in regional and national championships. There is also a Canadian Football League with eight professional teams. The most important CFL competition is the Grey Cup, which millions of fans watch on TV every year.

BASKETBALL isn't the most popular team sport in Canada, which is surprising because a Canadian teacher invented the game in 1891. James Naismith was working at a school in the USA when he had an idea for a new team sport. Nowadays, Canadian students often play basketball in PE class and it's also a typical after-school activity. At the moment, there is only one professional basketball team in Canada – the Toronto Raptors – which competes in the NBA. There are also Canadian players on other NBA teams
